



Remote Learning Provision Statement

Trinity All Saints CE Primary School is committed to ensuring continuity of learning for all pupils in the event of a sudden or extended school closure. This policy outlines the arrangements for remote home learning to support pupils, parents and staff, while maintaining realistic expectations and promoting pupil wellbeing.

In the Event of Sudden or Short-Term Closure

In the case of a sudden closure (e.g. bad weather or building issues lasting a short period of time):

Pupils will be directed to complete suggested home learning activities linked to the curriculum overview for their year group.

All pupils are expected to:

- Read their school reading book daily
- Access TT Rockstars (where appropriate)

Additional optional activities may include:

- Writing tasks
- Maths practice
- Topic-based activities linked to current learning

These activities are intended to reinforce prior learning and keep children engaged in a familiar routine.

Extended School Closure

If a closure is extended beyond a short period, the school will email work packs to parents and carers, containing a range of learning activities.

Work packs will:

- Align with current classroom learning
- Include tasks across core and foundation subjects
- Contain a balance of practical, written and creative activities

Digital platforms such as TT Rockstars and reading will continue to be used alongside these packs.
