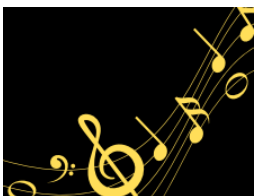

Dear Parents and Carers,

What an action-packed first half term we've had at Trinity All Saints C E Primary School! I'm delighted to share some highlights and important updates with you.

Our pupils have transitioned beautifully into their new classes, embracing our school values with a positive start to the year. We've been particularly excited about our geographical fieldwork, which has been taking place both locally and further afield, enhancing our pupils' curriculum learning through hands-on experiences. We have had numerous compliments from members of the public whilst on visits about how respectful and well-behaved the children have been and we are extremely proud of them.

I want to take a moment to celebrate some wonderful recent events. A huge thank-you to everyone who attended our Mad Hatter's Tea Party and trail - it was a great success, raising £165 for school funds. It has also been lovely to welcome parents and carers to our Friday worship, where we have celebrated pupils receiving ACT awards.



Our school choir had an incredible opportunity to participate in the Big Sing, joining over 1000 Bradford primary school children at St. George's Hall. If your child is interested in joining the choir, we're actively encouraging new members, with exciting events planned for the next half term.

Last week, our Year 6 pupils took their learning beyond the classroom with a visit to Bradford Broadway Shopping Centre. As part of their geography fieldwork, they investigated footfall patterns and explored the variety of businesses operating in the centre. Pupils conducted surveys, made observations, and gathered data to better understand how different types of shops attract customers. It was a fantastic opportunity to apply real-world skills and learn more about our local economy!



We were thrilled to host our first World Faith Day, which was a fantastic learning experience. All our pupils were fully engaged in a morning of learning about Hinduism, followed by a special Diwali lunch - a truly enriching cultural experience.





Extra-curricular activities

Our Running Club will continue on Mondays, and Music Club will continue on Thursdays. Jimmy's School of Martial Arts sessions will begin on Monday 3rd November and run for 6 weeks. Those who have secured a place have been informed and should pay Jimmy directly using the provided bank details. Pupils who didn't get a space this time will be placed on a waiting list for the next opportunity unless we hear otherwise.

We have some exciting new after-school clubs beginning in Autumn 2, and separate information will follow about these, including sign-up details and payment information for chargeable clubs.

Food and drink in school

I also need to make a few polite reminders about food and drink in school. Please do not send children with juice in water bottles. Additionally, we must be strict about nut products - please do not send ANY items containing NUTS, including ALL chocolate spread or chocolate-filled products like pancakes. We have pupils with severe nut allergies, and we cannot guarantee the safety of these items. We're also noticing an increase in the number of unhealthy items in packed lunches (multiple per lunchbox), so we kindly ask you to be mindful and encourage healthy snack choices.

Christmas productions

We will be trialing a new format for Christmas productions to provide more opportunities for children to be involved and perform. EYFS will perform a traditional nativity, Y1/2 will perform a Christmas play based on the nativity, and Y3-6 will perform a Christmas musical, 'Hosanna Rock' at All Saints Church in the Christmas service. We hope you can join us for these special productions to celebrate the Christmas season.

We have lots of exciting things planned for Autumn 2, most of which are outlined here, and any further dates (including educational visits), will be added as the new half term begins.

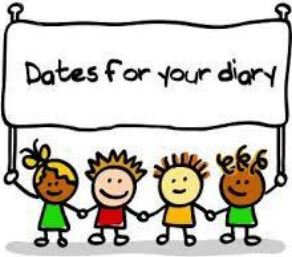
