Our Attendance Goals

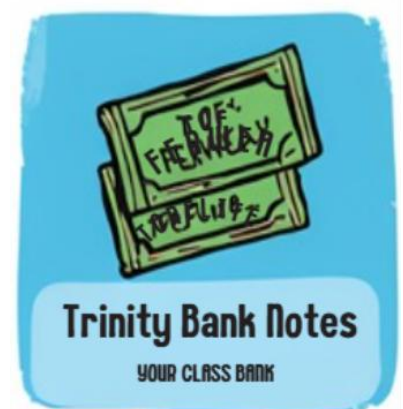
We aim for a minimum of **95% attendance**, with an ideal target of **97%+**. In Autumn Term, we noticed a slight dip in attendance compared to our usual high standards at Trinity All Saints, and we're committed to supporting our pupils in being present and engaged.

New Attendance Rewards and Incentives

Class Rewards: Trinity Bank

Today we launched our very own 'Trinity Bank' to motivate our classes. Each week classes with the following attendance will receive special Trinity Bank notes to put towards their class 'bank'. At the end of the year, each class can spend their earnings on a treat of their choice! Nearly every class achieved between 95% and 98% in our first week – well done!

- 95% attendance = £1
- 96% attendance = £2
- 97% attendance = £3
- 98% attendance = £4
- 99% attendance = £5
- 100% attendance = £10
