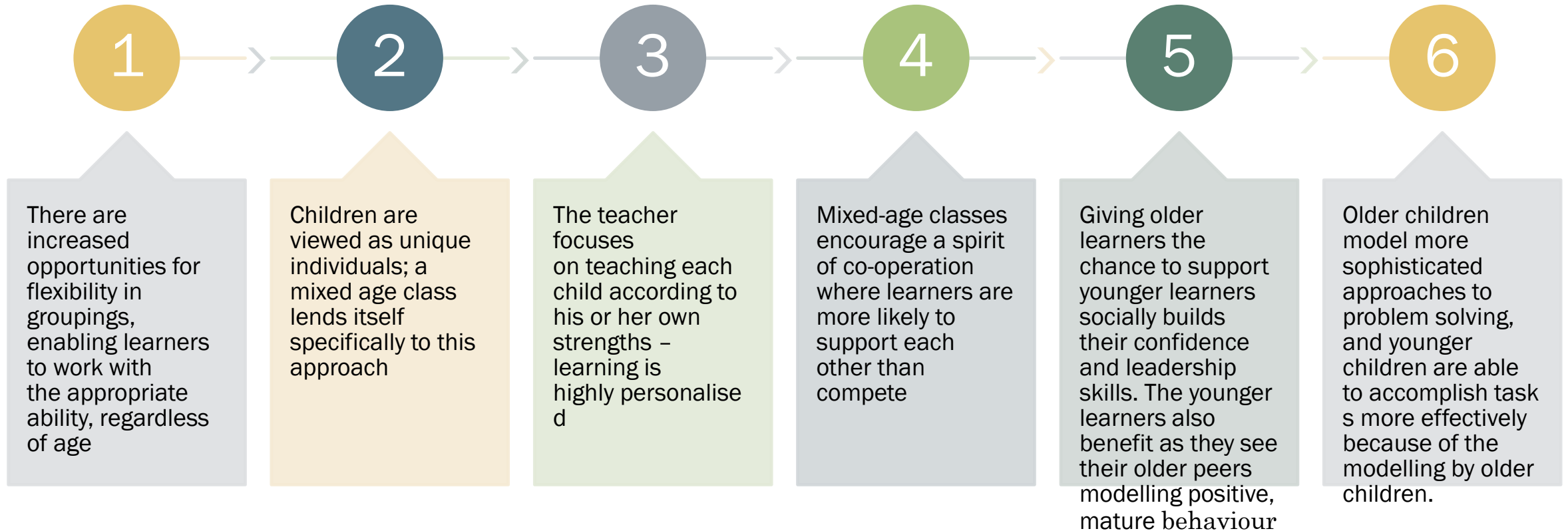



At Trinity All Saints, leaders have made the decisions to move to mixed-age classes, carefully matching class teachers with year groups they are familiar with teaching.

CURRICULUM

Early Years – children will access the full early years curriculum. They will learn through purposeful play opportunities both in and outside the classroom.

Phonics will be taught to pupils in their individual year groups (regardless of which class they are in)

Key Stage 2 (Years 3-6)

Mathematics/science/PSHE (inc. RSE) will be taught to pupils in their individual year groups

Foundation subjects and English will be taught in classes – a carefully designed, four-year cycle will ensure the entire curriculum is covered. Children will develop the essential disciplinary skills required to prepare them for secondary school

All educational visits will continue to be a key element within the curriculum. Trips will be organised in such a way that larger groups can go, therefore reducing the overall costs.

Mrs F Moran and Mrs R Timms will provide additional teaching capacity, enabling key subjects to be taught in separate years groups. PPA cover will be provided by the teaching team.

The support team will be distributed to classes dependent on individual pupil needs.

The allocation of classes will largely be based on children's ages. School will be holding a small number of individual meetings with a number of families to discuss the most appropriate class for their child, prior to transition day.
