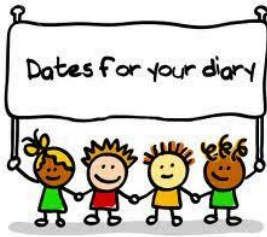
Thank you for your continued support throughout this term. We are incredibly proud of our children's achievements and look forward to another successful term after the Easter holidays.
